- As of February 3<sup>rd</sup>, East Canyon is 54% full, Echo Reservoir is 32% full, and the Weber River basin snow water equivalent is 88% of normal. Currently almost 94% of the state of Utah is in severe to exceptional drought condition. As of January 4, 2022, the District's boundaries were moved to the severe drought category.
- Due to material supply issues, the Meter Retrofit Project for WaterSMART Grant R22AP00053 will be postponed until after the water season unless the material arrives sooner. If it does, the contractor may install the meters during the water season.
- HB242 is a secondary water metering bill that a group of secondary water suppliers are concerned about. We have been talking to everyone we can, and we hope to schedule a meeting with the bill sponsor soon.
